
# My name is Cassie! I'm seven and I live with my

Mom and my little brother, Marcus. I love my family and they love me! (I also really love to draw.)






Mom had to WOrk a lot to take care of us. Sometimes she couldn't buy all the food we wanted to eat, and we would be hungry.



We lived in a house that Mom could afford in a neighborhood where everything **Seemed** like it was always gray, with empty lots everywhere, and no play areas.




# Sometimes I had a hard time sleeping - nighttime didn't feel safe.




I wanted to go to school close by, but our neighborhood school, and lots of others had closed. Marcus and I had a hard time and my teachers told me



## I was behind in my school.






Then something happened;

They had come to our neighborhood and fixed up a house to be a family center.




## She said the house had everything we needed!

with a buddy. It was a lot more fun than I thought it would be!






Mom did activities too.
